## **Sunday Reflection**

SUNDAY, JANUARY 1, 2023

#### **READINGS**

Numbers 6:22-27 Psalms 67:2-3, 5, 6, 8 Galatians 4:4-7 Luke 2:16-21

Today we celebrate a New Year of the Lord, and specifically in the Church, we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. This Solemnity expresses God's love for all humanity as he takes on our human nature being born of a woman named Mary, who through her "Yes" to God, becomes our spiritual mother, the mother of all of God's adopted children.

Saint Paul, in his letter to the Galatians, explains that they are now adopted children because God has sent his Son Jesus the Christ to be born of a woman. This is important for us to understand. The Galatians, as people who are new to faith in Jesus, and as people who have felt that they were abandoned and searching for a



Messiah, now have been claimed as children of God. What a joy for them, and yet how difficult it must have been for them to feel that God could love them enough to choose them for himself.

Mary helps remind us that God does choose those whom he wishes to serve him. That is why not only our country but our diocese as well is under the auspice of Mary. God has chosen us to be the beneficiary of God's love and Mary's yes, as the only Son of God has entered the world.


### **Food Giving Weekend**


