READINGS

Acts 6:1-7 Psalms 33:1-2, 4-5, 18-19 1 Peter 2:4-9 John 14:6

"You are 'a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people of his own, so that you may announce the praises' of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light."

In today's First Letter of Peter, the above phrase follows the description of Jesus as the stone that the builders rejected. That rejected stone has now become the cornerstone, our foundation. God the Father, on the foundation that Christ has laid down for us, namely his own body, builds us as the chosen race and royal priesthood. Christ, the Savior of the world is our foundation. HOSPITALIZED OR HOMEBOUND?


