Sunday Reflection

SUNDAY, AUGUST 6, 2023

READINGS

Daniel 7:9-10, 13-14 Psalms 97:1-2, 5-6, 9 2 Peter 1:16-19 Matthew 17:1-9

One of the things we do not think about when we envision Jesus is the great glory he experienced as the son of God in heaven. We think of him as someone just like us, a human being with the same qualities, the same limitations, and the same flaws as the rest of us. While Jesus is truly man, he is also truly God; he is God incarnate. This weekend's feast of the Transfiguration recalls the day when Christ was on Mount Tabor with his disciples and in their sight he was transfigured. The glory with which he stood before them is the glory he had before he came to earth to suffer and die for us-a glory which awaits us on the last day when we too, will enter the kingdom of heaven and be counted among the elect.

The first reading from the book of Daniel speaks of this glory. We hear about the glory of God, of his magnificent appearance, and of his dazzlingly white robes. The second reading from St Peter (a witness to the Transfiguration) also speaks of the glory of Christ. The gospel text from St Luke recounts the Transfiguration of the Lord on the mountain in the presence of Peter, James, and John. While the disciples look on, Jesus' appearance is changed and his clothes appear to be dazzlingly white while he speaks with Moses and Elijah. In this gospel reading, we can recognize that Jesus is greater than both the Law and the Prophets. As with Christ's baptism in the Jordan, the Father's voice sounds from heaven to proclaim his satisfaction with his Son.

Our faith tells us that Jesus is truly God and truly man. As a man, he is indeed one of us. But as God, he is

FAITH FORMATION

YOUTH DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS

Youth discipleship builds on the intellectual foundation found in Faith Formation and creates opportunities for fellowship and deeper spiritual growth. Youth discipleship groups for middle school and high school students are usually bi-weekly throughout the school year and also include some fun events and trips.

FIRST COMMUNION PREP - 2ND GRADE

Preparation and celebration for the Sacraments of First Penance and First Eucharist is a complementary process that typically take place during a child's second grade year. First Penance is celebrated in the fall, and First Eucharist is then celebrated in the spring. Deadline to register is September 10, 2023

*A prerequisite to First Penance and First Eucharist Prep is that students have attended and continue to attend a Catholic school or participated in a Faith Formation program in first grade and continue to participate.

CONFIRMATION PREP - 10TH GRADE

Confirmation preparation takes place during a teen's sophomore year of high school. Deadline to register is September 24, 2023. To learn more and to register, visit holycrossdewitt.org/cdp

Parish Eucharistic Revival

The following is taken from The Divine Encounter: Meeting Jesus in Eucharistic Adoration by Mark Hart.

"Whether you are a "seasoned vet" when it comes to Adoration or the entire concept is new to you, the reality is that the Eucharist is our greatest gift as Catholics. The opportunity to worship the Lord and adore him in his Most Blessed Sacrament is one that cannot be understated or taken for granted. Through the Eucharist, we have an opportunity for intimacy with the Lord unlike what any other denomination can offer. We are blessed beyond measure.

And while Adoration is most often thought of as taking place before the exposed Eucharist, it can also be done before the reserved Eucharist in the tabernacle,"

The church sanctuary and chapel are open daily for Adoration. There is no Adoration during a Mass, be it daily, Sunday, funeral Mass, school Mass or other occasion. Outside Mass times, the chapel and church are available for Adoration whenever the church is open. Two scheduled times of Adoration are Monday 8:15 AM - 9:15 AM in the chapel and Wednesday 7:00 PM - 8:00 PM in the church. The Sacrament of Confession is also available Wednesdays from 7:00 PM - 8:00 PM.


