## **Sunday Reflection**

SUNDAY, AUGUST 20, 2023

### **READINGS**

Isaiah 56:1, 6-7 Psalms 67:2-3, 5, 6, 8 Romans 11:13-15, 29-32 Matthew 15:21-28

Each week in the readings of Sunday Mass we tend to see overarching themes. Today's theme is the question of the insider versus the outsider. Although important to human beings, God shatters the divisions that humans use to separate themselves from others.

A human reality is that each group, whether religious, cultural, political, or national, clearly states what they believe and with whom they identify. These groups do this to delineate themselves from other groups around them. While some of these delineations are necessary, when it comes to Jesus, we see him break out of the limitations imposed on him by his cultural identity.

We would be mistaken if we believed the culture Jesus was born into did not affect him personally. If he was not impacted, it would make what Jesus did somewhat less important, or indeed, less remarkable. Jesus' culture did affect him but he succeeded in bringing the outsider, those that society thought of as unclean or unworthy of God, to the forefront of his ministry. It was these people that he cured, forgave and loved. Where would we be today if Jesus had not broken out of these cultural expectations? Salvation would not be possible!

As for us, we are insiders because of our belief in Christ, but can be outsiders due to our sin. Through the forgiveness that we receive from Jesus, are we willing to reach out to everyone around us and invite him or her to the table of Christ? If so, then the outsider becomes the insider, and we help continue the work of Jesus!

### **FAITH FORMATION**

Faith Formation classes are available for students in grades 1-12 and take place one day a week before school and include breakfast and busing to schools in JD Central School District. Register before Sept. 1 to get your free house shirt!

### YOUTH DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS

Youth discipleship builds on the intellectual foundation found in Faith Formation and creates opportunities for fellowship and deeper spiritual growth. Youth discipleship groups for middle school and high school students are usually bi-weekly throughout the school year and also include some fun events and trips.

### FIRST COMMUNION PREP - 2ND GRADE

Preparation and celebration for the Sacraments of First Penance and First Eucharist is a complementary process that typically take place during a child's second grade year. First Penance is celebrated in the fall, and First Eucharist is then celebrated in the spring. Deadline to register is September 10, 2023

\*A prerequisite to First Penance and First Eucharist Prep is that students have attended and continue to attend a Catholic school or participated in a Faith Formation program in first grade and continue to participate.

### **CONFIRMATION PREP - 10TH GRADE**

Confirmation preparation takes place during a teen's sophomore year of high school. Deadline to register is September 24, 2023. To learn more and to register, visit holycrossdewitt.org/cdp

\*A prerequisite to Confirmation Prep is that students have attended and continue to attend a Catholic school or participated in a Faith Formation program in ninth grade and continue to participate during prep year.


