Music is a force, and a craft, and an art which goes beyond what words sometimes inadequately express. The Scripture is the Living Word of God and comes to life more pointedly when we sing the Mass, the responses, the hymns. The Choir, Cantor and Soloists encourage, inspire, and lift us from the mundane outside world. When I was in Elementary School, the Franciscan nun told the class that we can express what we do at Mass with the word ACTS, standing for Adoration, Contrition, Thanksgiving and Supplication. 
